- At most, one upper division undergraduate course is allowed to replace one of the formal graduate level courses -- provided that (i) the undergraduate course (or equivalent course) is not required of undergraduate students in the Electrical Engineering department, and (ii) the undergraduate course is approved by the student's faculty advisor. A list of courses that may not be used can be obtained from the Electrical Engineering Student Affairs Office (57-127).
- A student's Program of Study must consist of courses that provide a curriculum of breadth and depth that is rigorous in nature.
- For the comprehensive (project) option at least five (5), and for the thesis option at least four (4), of the formal graduate courses required must be in the Electrical Engineering Department.
